To Whom It May Concern:

In an effort to accommodate members of the public with chemical sensitivities, the PUCN will place signage at the front of each building asking the public as a courtesy to refrain from wearing personal care products with synthetic fragrances while in the building. Specifically, the signs will state:

"To accommodate individuals who enter the Commission office who are chemically sensitive to fragrances and other scented products, please use sparingly or not at all: perfume, aftershave, scented hand lotion, fragranced hair products, and/or similar products."

PUCN notices of all consumer sessions will contain similar language. Further, any member of the public affronted by a chemical or synthetic fragrance scent may request to watch PUCN proceedings from the adjoining hearing room, and the PUCN will accommodate this request if the adjoining hearing room is available.
