


Toxic chemicals are in your home



PFCs (perfluorinated compounds)

Used in:

- clothing
- coolers
- food containers
- carpets



BPA (bisphenol A)

Used in:

- food can linings
- baby bottles
- receipt paper
- CDs and DVDs

Formaldehyde

Used in:

- carpeting
- soaps and detergents
- cabinetry
- glues and adhesives



Phthalates

Used in:

- air fresheners
- paper
- vinyl tile
- wood varnishes and lacquers



Toluene

Used in:

- paints
- flooring adhesives
- plumbing adhesives
- adhesive removers


PBDEs (polybrominated diphenyl ethers)

Used as flame retardants in:

- furniture
- electrical equipment
- TVs and computers
